CMS POLICIES

Community Music School holds 20 teaching studios and a 200-seat performance hall. With more than 500 students participating in our music programs each week, Community Music School has become the region's premiere resource for the highest quality music education.

TUITION

Tuition is billed monthly. Invoices are sent out at the time of registration and billed on the first of the month starting August 1st (payment applied to the following month), basically pre-paying your last month of lessons for the school year. 30 days' notice is required to drop enrollment. Enrollment is rolling, and tuition will be prorated for students who begin lessons after the start of the typical school year. Enrollment is continuous for the entire school year unless properly withdrawn. *Financial Assistance and Merit Scholarships are available for those who qualify* Please contact the Registrar with any questions at info@cmsmusic.org or 610-489-3676.

ATTENDANCE

Students are eligible for up to <u>two make-up lessons per year</u> provided we receive notification via phone or email with 24-hour advanced notice. No refunds or make-ups are given for class/ensemble tuition after the start of the first class or rehearsal. Students are not entitled to more than 2 make-up lessons per year for missed lessons. However, should your teacher need to cancel your lesson, he/she is required to reschedule that missed lesson. Make-up lessons are scheduled by your teacher. The teacher is obligated to offer three opportunities for each make-up; if the student refuses all three, the make-up is forfeited. There are designated weeks during the school year to accommodate make-up lessons. You must be a current student to receive any make-up lessons.

STUDENT RECITALS

Performance is an important aspect of any musician's life. Throughout the year, there are numerous recitals, concerts and master classes which provide CMS students the opportunity to set goals and develop necessary performance skills. Students are encouraged to take advantage of these opportunities. Student Recitals are generally scheduled on selected Friday evenings at 7pm. The schedule is posted on the website: **www.cmsmusic.org** and posted at CMS.

How do I sign up for a recital?

When your teacher feels that you are prepared to perform, he/she will sign you up for an agreed-upon recital date.

WITHDRAWALS

All withdrawals from a private lesson or class must have 30 days' notice and be submitted to the Registrar in writing. A verbal notification to your teacher does not constitute an official withdrawal from lessons. Tuition will be pro-rated, minus a \$25.00 withdrawal fee.
